



Updated Covid-19 Protocol as of August 12, 2022:

Positive Test:

Day 0: Day of onset of symptoms, if there are no symptoms then day of positive test

Days 1-5: must isolate at home and not return to school

Ending Isolation:

If you have no symptoms: you may end isolation after day 5

If you have symptoms: you may end isolation after day 5 if:

- You are fever-free for 24 hours
- Your symptoms are improving

****If you are still experiencing symptoms continue to isolate until you meet the guidelines above**

Removing your mask:

After isolation has ended, when you are feeling better (no fever and symptoms improving):

- Wear your mask through day 10 (if you return to school/work on day 6 you must wear a mask through day 10 unless you have a negative test result)
- OR
- You may test on day 6, if negative you can discontinue mask use
- If this is a child under age 2 or a child with special needs who cannot wear a mask properly, you may also test on day 6, if negative, individual can return to school/work with no mask.

Exposure to a positive staff member or student:

Quarantine for an exposure is no longer required for any age:

- If there is a positive case in a classroom, the parents/guardians will be notified on ProCare
- Parents/guardians will decide whether their child will return to school the following day
- Parents/guardians will decide whether their child will return to school with a mask or not
 - Note: Sisu staff IS NOT responsible for ensuring that a child wears a mask properly throughout the duration of the school day, that will be up to the parent/guardians to show the child how to wear the mask
 - Note: children under the age of 2 are not to wear a mask per the CDC current guidelines
- Any Sisu staff member working in a classroom with a positive case will be required to wear a mask for 10 days following the exposure
